IN-TOWN TROLLEY NETWORK

HART's In-Town Trolley Green and Purple lines serve Downtown and Channelside providing quick, convenient transportation from major public parking and downtown hotels to shopping, restaurants, museums, galleries, performing arts, nightlife and major points of interest. Trolleys connect with the TECO Line Streetcar. Every 10 minutes, only \$.25/ride, hours vary.

• Sunday, 1 p.m. to 8 p.m.
Between Garrison Channel and Whiting is enforced:
• Monday thru Saturday, 8 a.m. to midnight
